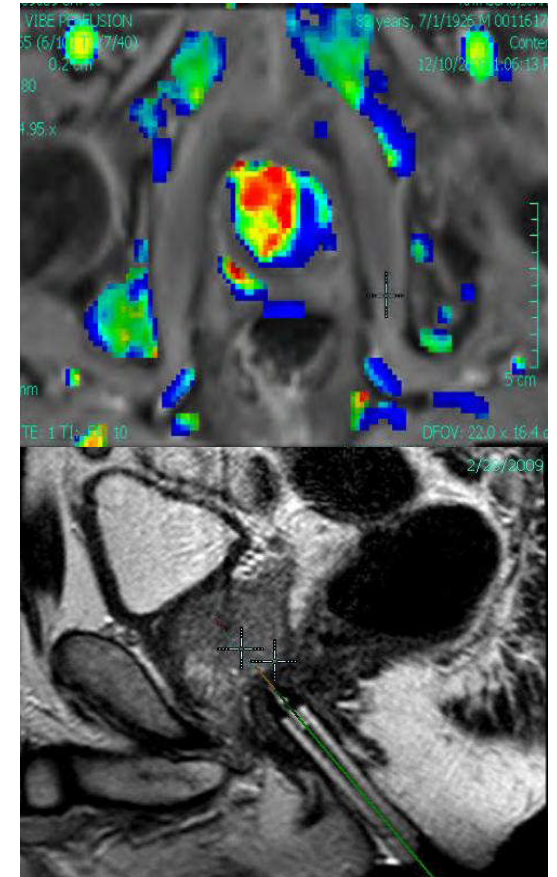

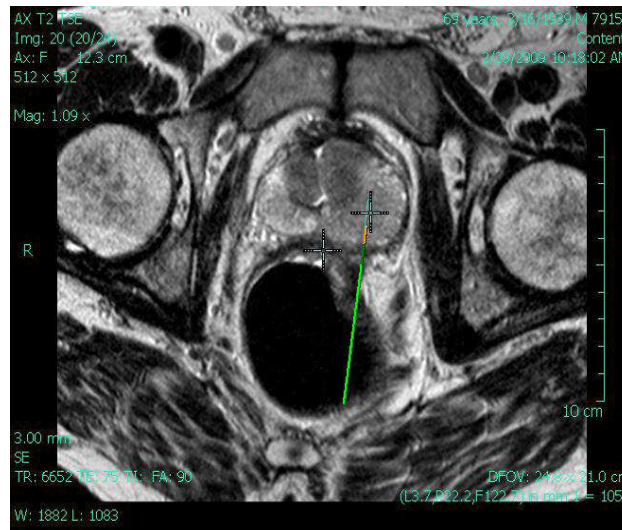
PROSTATE CANCER FACTS

- Prostate cancer is the most frequently diagnosed cancer in men
- 232,090 new cases in the United States in 2005
- Estimate for 2007: 218,890 new cases, with 27,050 prostate deaths (versus 180,510 new breast cancer cases and 40,910 deaths)
- Approx. 30% of ALL expected male cancer cases in 2007
- 1 out of 6 men will develop prostate cancer during his lifetime compared to 1 out of 8 women developing breast cancer
- Over 2 million American men currently live with prostate cancer
- Incidence has increased by 1.7 % in the US from 1995-2002

CURRENT STANDARD FOR DIAGNOSIS

- PSA (Prostate Specific Antigen) test
- DRE (Digital Rectal Exam)
- If DRE finding or PSA level abnormal, then a TRUS (transrectal ultrasound guided) biopsy is done
 - Follow-up for negative biopsies is repeating PSA test & TRUS biopsy

ARE YOU A CANDIDATE FOR PROSTATE MRI?

- Elevated Prostate-Specific Antigen (PSA levels) >4
- Rising PSA levels
- Negative prior trans-rectal ultrasound-guided biopsies
- Positive digital rectal examination with negative trans-rectal ultrasound-guided biopsies

EARLY DETECTION MRI - A New Choice

Finding cancer early means treatment begins earlier. MRI can help localize tumor sites for biopsy.
